Day 2 Easter Island

Breakfast. Full day excursion visiting the archaeological centre of Akahanga, the Rano Raraku quarry where all the existing Moais were sculpted, with over 300 Moais in different stages of their completion, Ahu Tongariki, with its archaeological ruins of once the largest platform on the island until washed away by a tidal wave in 1969, Te Pito Kura, Ahu Ngau Ngau, including picnic lunch on Anakena Beach with its crystal-clear emerald-green waters. Lodging

Day 3 Easter Island

Breakfast. During the morning, visit to Rano Kau volcano, (1,6 km in diameter), the ceremonial village of Orongo with the largest concentration of Petroglyphs with images of Tangata Manu, the birdman, gods Make Make and Komari, fertility symbols and Vinapu. Time off for lunch. In the afternoon, sightseeing tour of Ahu Akivi, site of the seven Moais overlooking the sea, the Caves of Ana Tepahu, among the largest on the island and Pun-a-Pau quarries on the slopes of a volcano and where the reddish topknots were sculpted. Return to the hotel. Lodging.

Day 4 Easter Island

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport.

Day 1 Puerto Montt – Puerto Varas

Welcome at Puerto Montt airport and transfer to the city of Puerto Varas. Accommodation at the hotel of your choice. Tour around the cities of Puerto Montt and Puerto Varas. Lodging.

Day 2 Puerto Varas - Osorno Volcano Ski and Mountain Center

Breakfast. Depending on weather conditions, departure for a full day tour of the Osorno Volcano Ski and Mountain Center and the Petrohué River Falls in the Vicente Perez Rosales National Park to get to the Todos los Santos Lake, also known as the Emerald Lake because of the green-blue color of its water. Lunch included. At night, we suggest going out to taste the regional cuisine in some of the many restaurants of the promenade or visit the casino. Lodging.

Day 3 Puerto Varas – Optional Tours

Breakfast. Full day to enjoy optional excursions around the Llanquihue Lake, or the Island of Chiloé or Frutillar. Lodging.

* From September to April (Spring-Summer season) a Full day sailing excursion can be taken on the Todos los Santos Lake to Peulla and back.

Day 4 Puerto Varas

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport, pier or to begin the voyage across the lake towards Bariloche (Argentina).

Day 1 Punta Arenas – Puerto Natales

Day 2 Puerto Natales – Serrano and Balmaceda Glaciers

Breakfast. At 8 o'clock, it is boarding time at Puerto Natales pier for a full day excursion sailing towards the Serrano and Balmaceda glaciers. At approximately 4:30 p.m., return to the pier. Lodging ** Daily Navigation during the months of September through March. From April to September only on Sundays and depending on weather conditions

Day 3 Puerto Natales –Torres del Paine National Park

Breakfast. In the morning, departure from the hotel, for a full day tour to the Torres del Paine National Park. Lunch included. In the evening, return to the hotel. Lodging.

TRAVEL PROGRAM

Leaving from Ushuaia, sailing through the Beagle Channel, exploring Cape Horn and crossing the mythical waters of the Drake Passage, Antarctica XXI invites you to participate in a unique experience that will take you to one of the most remote places on earth, the coldest, highest, windiest, driest, and most inhospitable continent - Antarctica.

DAY 1

The journey begins in Ushuaia, Argentina. After meeting at the selected hotel, we will proceed to the local port to embark on our vessel, the Professor Multanovskiy. We will sail along the Beagle Channel towards Puerto Williams, the southernmost town in the world, located on Navarino Island. Here, we will have the time to tour around before setting sail toward Cape Horn.

PLEASE NOTE: Passengers are required to be in Ushuaia, in a hotel to be defined, at 14:00 hours.

DAY 2

After crossing Nassau Bay, we will wake up in front of legendary Cape Horn! Weather permitting, we will put our Zodiac boats into the water and visit its lighthouse and the Chilean station in charge of keeping it beaming. Back on board, we will get ready to set sail towards Antarctica and start the crossing of the famous waters named in honour of Sir Francis Drake, the great XVIth century British explorer.

DAY 3

Sailing through the Drake Passage, en route to King George Island (South Shetland Islands). We invite you to relax and enjoy life on board and to take the time to watch wildlife from the bridge or from the outside decks. We may spot magnificent birds such as albatrosses and petrels, as well as Humpback and Minke whales swimming on their way down to Antarctica.

DAY 4

Once we have crossed the Antarctic Convergence, we will be sailing through the Antarctic Ocean. The time has come to start spotting the first icebergs and the first Antarctic land. The South Shetland Islands finally come into view, and we will have the opportunity to put our zodiac boats into the water and make our first landing to visit a penguin colony. Exploration will continue all evening thanks to the endless daylight.

DAY 5

Upon reaching King George Island, we will disembark at Fildes Bay, where we will have the chance to enjoy the Antarctic scenery and visit some interesting places around the area, such as the Chilean Base Frei and the Russian Base Bellingshausen. We will gather at the aerodrome where we will board the flight that will take us to Punta Arenas, Chile. The programme ends upon arrival at the Airport in Punta Arenas.

Transfer to the city will be available for passengers staying overnight in Punta Arenas.

The above mentioned program includes:

- Transfer to the port of Ushuaia.
- Cruising for 5 days and 4 nights from Ushuaia to Frei Station on King George Island.
- All meals and beverages on board.
- All guided shore excursions.
- Lectures and entertainment on board.
- Flight from Frei Station on King George Island to Punta Arenas.
- Comprehensive pre- and post-voyage information material.
- Loan of waterproof boots for landing in Antarctica.

The above mentioned program does not include:

- Accommodation and meals other than those included in the program.
- Transfers other than those included in the program.
- Visa and/or Passport expenses.
- Arrival and/or departures taxes.
- Communication expenses.
- Laundry expenses.
- Gratuities
- Personal insurance.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:

The maximum weight allowed on the flights to and from Antarctica is 20 kg per passenger, including hand luggage. Excess baggage will be transferred to Punta Arenas, free of charge, and will be delivered to passengers upon return from Antarctica.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

Every effort will be made to adhere to the planned program. However, it must be realized that with this type of adventurous travel to Antarctica, changes to the itinerary may occur due to severe and unpredictable weather. We need to emphasize the fact that weather conditions are unpredictable and safety is always the paramount concern on any Antarctic voyage.

For this reason, Antarctica XXI reserves the right to change the itinerary here described due to weather conditions or other factors beyond Antarctica XXI's control without consulting the participants. Any change to the planned itinerary will be made exclusively and absolutely according to the judgment of the Captain of the aircraft or the vessel. It is understood that such decisions will be made in the best interests of all the passengers and with regard to the safety of the vessel and the aircraft.

A tight time-schedule connection with an Antarctic expedition is unwise. For this reason, Antarctica XXI strongly suggests that a flexible air ticket be held for your journey home, and in any case, not to book a flight on the same day of the return flight from Antarctica.

In case that the flight to or from Antarctica cannot take place due to unfavorable weather conditions either at point of origin and/or destination, Antarctica XXI will apply the Contingency Plan corresponding to each trip.
